

Information related to new influenza when travelling to Japan

Announcement date: May 22, 2009

1. The Japanese government is taking all measures possible to prevent further spread of the new influenza.
2. The government is implementing following inspection at airports and we ask all travelers for their kind understandings and cooperation for this measure.
 - (1) Health inspection officials ask all passengers fill out questionnaires onboard asking if there are any symptoms such as fever or coughing.
 - (2) Passengers with poor health conditions are given medical examinations.
 - (3) Passengers seated nearby suspected patient are required to contact to the below medical facilities if they feel their health condition is not good as usual.
3. As certain numbers of domestic infection cases were confirmed in several areas in Japan such as Osaka and Hyogo, the central government and local authorities are taking utmost efforts to prevent further spread of the virus.
4. We sincerely hope that travelers visiting Japan understand the situation and recommend prepare masks when visiting crowded area. In case travelers wish to have contact with the medical facilities, please contact the following Medical Centers first.
